Class Schedules

Student schedules will be available on August 19th. Students will access their schedules through the student schedule module in Tyler 360. Please be sure to change your view from Today to **ALL** to see classes. The Today view will not work until the first day of school. Any scheduling concerns should be addressed at the building level with the Principal or Guidance Counselor.



Transportation

Transportation information will now be available in student portal on August 19th. This includes your InBound and OutBound Bus Number, Bus Stops and Bus Times. Please check your Transportation Information before the first day of school. Online Registration

New this year, parents will be required to update information through the online registration portal. Student and parent demographic data will need to be reviewed and accepted. We will also be collecting electronic signatures for our Computer and Network Acceptable Use Policy, Office 365 Account Information, and Student Handbooks Online. Parents are required to review these documents (links provided) with their children. Once you have completed all of the necessary online registration forms, you can submit them to the district. Once all forms are submitted, you will see the submitted icon.

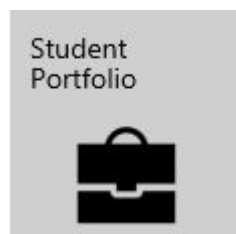

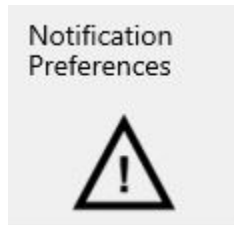

Username and Password for Parent or Guardian

All primary contacts will have an account to access the Tyler 360 portal. The username for the Tyler 360 PARENT Portal is the **parent's first name and last name separated by a period**. For example, if my name is Bob Smith, then my username is **bob.smith** in the Tyler 360 portal. If there is a duplicate contact name or user in the database, the username may be followed by a "1". For example, bob.smith1.

The password for the Tyler 360 portal will be your **child's 6-digit student ID number**. (It's usually the oldest child, but sometimes the system assigns a different child.) Once you log in for the first time, the system will prompt you to change it. We recommend that you change it to something you can remember. If at any time, you forget your username or password, you can contact the helpdesk to reset it, by sending an email to: tylersis@ambridge.k12.pa.us. Please include your name and the student name associated with your account in your email.

Username and Password for Students

All K-12 students will have an account to access the Tyler 360 portal. **The username for the Tyler 360 Portal is the student email address**. The student email address is the student's network username followed by the student email domain (@ambridgearea.org). All student email addresses follow the same pattern. The first two characters are the intended graduation year. The next two characters are the first two letters of the student's first name. The next string of characters is the student's entire last name. The last two characters are the last two digits of the student ID number.

The password for the Tyler 360 portal will be the student ID number. The students will be prompted to change it when they log into the system. We recommend that they change it to their network login password. This is the password they use for almost all of the programs in the Ambridge Area School District. However, this is just a suggestion. Students can choose any password that fits the Tyler 360 password requirements. See example below.
