The Hal Galupi Scholarship Fund was created to provide financial assistance to one graduating senior scholar-athlete of Ambridge Area High School. To apply for this scholarship, students must:

1. Plan to attend an accredited college/university or career/technical school.
2. Maintain at least a 3.0 grade point average while displaying academic effort.
3. Demonstrate leadership in an athletic program sponsored by A.A.H.S.
4. Demonstrate a commitment to and involvement in extra-curricular and/or community activities.
5. Complete, staple, and submit all information requested on the scholarship application to the Guidance Office **by 3 p.m. on March 31, 2025.**

The family of Hal Galupi will select and notify the scholarship recipient. The recipient must submit a letter of acceptance from the college/university or career/technical school of his/her choice to the family by August 1. The scholarship check will be sent directly to the financial aid office of the institution involved.

4. Letter of Acceptance by August 1
5. Official High School Transcript
